Water is at the core of sustainable development and is critical for socio-economic
development, healthy ecosystems and for human survival itself. Globally, water
scarcity already affects four out of every ten people. 2.2 million people die every year
due to Diseases caused by poor quality water. By 2025, 1.8 billion people are expected
to be living in countries with absolute water scarcity. Globally, 80% of waste water flows
back into the ecosystem without being treated or reused. 80% of all natural disasters
are water-related. Annual economic losses from water-related disasters are estimated
at between US \$ 250 billion and US \$ 500 billion. We can reduce the floods, droughts
