<p>Summary of the Event</p>	<p>There are few hamlets near Bhadrachalam where the tribals there are living in a dense forest. They have their own language called Koya language Most of the residents there are in BPL (below poverty line) and don't have access to electricity. The day to day activities get difficult when the light fades out.</p> <p>We found a hamlet consisting of 26 homes which are at a 5km radius from their neighbouring hamlets.</p> <p>Using solar cells we can convert solar energy (sunlight) directly to electricity. The electricity can be directly used in DC appliances or can be stored in batteries and used for the purpose of lighting whenever required. The solar house lighting system is very helpful in these hamlets and helps aid in bringing light into their homes.</p> <p>Taking the assistance of - @nur_foundation_ - we decided on distributing the households with solar panels. Each of the 26 homes were provided with a solar panel and 2 light bulbs. The team had made additional efforts in taking the commute via an electric vehicle to reduce emissions. The total distance travelled to and from Hyderabad to Bhadrachalam was 366 kms. The team started at 5:30 am and were back by 2 am the next day. The residents helped transport the equipment from the vehicle to the hamlet. The warranty for the system is 10 years by the company. installed hamlets.</p> <p>We would like to thank and are grateful to the donors of SC GRIET and @nur_foundation_ .</p>

<p>Summary of the Event</p>	<p>Jeevan (Alumni) Task Locations: Battugudem 27 Eruvendi 28 Krantinagar 12 Ontigudesa 10 Gangamma colony 15 Water Wheel is a plastic water drum that rolls on its side with help from a symmetrical handle bar. It is designed as a time saver for communities and households in which people carry water in jerry cans, pots and buckets on their heads. The wheels are helpful in tribal areas and rural areas where women cover many kms for bringing water. On survey, we found that there are few hamlets near Kothagudem where people live in total dense forests. They are complete tribals and have their own language. Most of them belong to the BPL (below poverty line). We observed that women walked 13-15kms for bringing water to their households every day. Hence, we decided to provide water wheels to each household so that it reduces burden and helps in faster delivery of water.
